Thevor • Your gift will help us care for patients like Trevor, who was rushed to the Emergency Department after suffering from chest pain.

"It was early evening, when I felt unwell. It was a crashing feeling, all of a sudden my heart felt cold, and I had a pain in my chest. The pain continued, so I decided to ring the ambulance."

"I was rushed to the Emergency Department, where doctors *immediately started treatment.* After I was stable, they transferred me to the Rapid Assessment Cardiac Unit where, further tests identified an irregularity with my heart beat which, if left unchecked could have been fatal. Since then I have had a pace maker fitted and receiving ongoing medication and assessment. Without the care I received at Peninsula Health. I hate to think what the outcome would have been."

Jane • Frankston local Jane Washington really understands the importance of her local hospital, when she was recently violently ill with stomach pain.

Our Surgeons spent nearly three hours operating on her to fix the cause of the pain – mutated scar tissue left over from an operation many years ago which had grown and knotted in her stomach.

"Everyone was supportive and encouraging. The care was 10/10 – I couldn't fault anything. I was very sick and I made a mess of the bathroom but nothing was too much for them. The staff work really hard, they get paid, but they're doing it not just for the money, they're doing it because they care, you can tell by the way they're treating you. They're fantastic."

CHOOSING THE RIGHT GIFT FOR YOU AND YOUR LOVED ONES

Gifts in Wills come in many different shapes and sizes. And of course, your loved ones come first.

Many of our supporters have chosen to leave 90 percent of their estate to family and loved ones, with the remaining 10 percent divided amongst the charities closest to their hearts.

No matter what your personal situation, you can choose to make a long-lasting and important difference.

Please speak to your solicitor about the type and size of gift that's right for you.

HOW TO INCLUDE A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

There are lots of ways you can make sure your loved ones are provided for and still leave a gift to your local hospital.

Here are the simple steps you can take if you choose to make the thoughtful decision to include a gift in your Will to your local hospital.

STEP 1 • THINK about the size and type of gift you want to include in your Will.

Most of our supporters choose to leave a proportion of the remainder of their Estates, after they have taken care of loved ones. This is called a 'residuary bequest gift'.

Every gift we receive – no matter the size – is important.

Talk to your solicitor about the most appropriate gift for your circumstances. **STEP 2** • **DECIDE** what you want your gift to go towards.

You may want your gift invested in an area of personal importance to you, or to keep your gift broad to meet the ever changing health needs of our community in the future.

It's important we have flexibility to invest your bequest in the best possible way. Most of our supporters choose to include a gift for 'general purpose', but if you would like to discuss how your gift will be used you can contact our Gifts in Wills team.

STEP 3 • **TALK** to your solicitor about including a gift when you next update your Will.

Ask your solicitor to include your chosen gift to Peninsula Health when writing or next updating your Will.

Take along a copy of this booklet, which has all the information your solicitor needs.

WE will treat your information and intentions with the strictest of confidence.

SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

Including a gift in your Will is such a simple thing to do.

You can ask your solicitor to insert the following clause into your Will:

I give free of all duties or taxes... [Please insert the appropriate statement from these options:]

- 1 the whole of my estate
- **2** [insert number] % of my estate
- **3** the residue of my estate
- **4** [insert number] % of the residue of my estate
- **5** the sum of \$ [insert value of your gift]
- 6 [insert number] of my [insert name of shares] shares

...to Peninsula Health (ABN 52 892 860 159) of 2 Hastings Road, Frankston Vic 3199 for its general purposes.

The official receipt of the organisation shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executor.
